Flowering plants that featured in the talk included

- Erysimum - 'Bowlé's Mauve' evergreen perennial, profuse flowering most of the year
- Lunaria Annuua - Honesty
- Euphorbia - Spurge
- Myosotis - Forget Me Not

Front Border

- Digitalis Foxglove - wild and garden cultivar species
- Hesperis Matronalis - sweet rocket
- Hardy perennial geraniums including Johnson's Blue
- Red Valerian
- Nepeta - Catmint
- Leucanthemum Vulgare - Ox Eye Daisy (wild flower)

Back Garden

- Astrantia Major - Great Masterwort
- Centaurea Scabiosa - Greater Knapweed (wild flower)
- Stachys officinalis - Betony (wild flower) and Stachys Officinalis Hummelo (garden cultivar species)
- All alliums but for summer - Allium Sphaerocephalon
- Achillea Yarrow (wild and garden cultivar species)
- Centaurea Cyanus - Cornflower
- Oregano vulgare - Wild Marjoram, Oreganum Laevigatum Herrenhausen (garden cultivar sp)
- Leucanthemum x superbum - Shasta Daisy
- Aster Amellus
- Michaelmas Daisy
- Eupatorium purpureum - Sweet Joe Pie Weed
- Schitzostylis - River Lily
- Acidanthera - Abyssinian gladioli
- Verbena Bonariensis
- Sedum - Autumn Joy
- Dipsacus fullonum
- Teasel wild flower - spreads very (or too) easily

Vegetable Companions

- Nasturtium
- Rudbeckia - sp Goldsturm
- Calendula
- Pot Marigold
- Tagetes Patula
- French Marigold, Tagetes erecta - Mexican marigold

Pond Plants included

- *Ranunculus aquatilis* - Water Crowfoot
- *Hydrocharis morsus-ranae* - Frogbit
- *Callitriche stagnalis* - Water Starwort
- *Fontinalis antipyretica* - Willow Moss
- *Nymphoides peltate* - Fringe Lily
